

**Wells Fargo Outdoor Lighting Retrofit/Alaska Village Energy Efficiency Program (VEEP)
Outdoor LED Lighting Projects
Minimum Purchasing Standards & Grantee Guidance**

To qualify for reimbursement, the lighting you purchase must meet all of the following criteria:

- Be Design Light Consortium (DLC) certified
- Have a five year warranty
- Have a (L85/100,000) rating
- Have a Color Rendering Index (CRI) of 70 or higher

Where do I find this information?

A lighting vendor can provide you with a fact sheet about their products and/or lighting package labels will include these details. Here are some examples:



Warranty:
Five year limited warranty

This shows that the L value is 85 and 89 depending on the temperature and meets the standards.
