Frequently Asked Questions FAQ's 3  
Summary of Weekly Questions – September 17-24, 2008**

**Project Eligibility Questions**

1. “Renewable energy resources” are defined to include “waste heat recovery”. Must the source of the heat be from renewable sources, or can it include diesel, coal or natural gas.

If the waste heat is currently being wasted, then the project is eligible (i.e., new projects to be designed and built to include waste heat recovery are not eligible).

2. How do you assure that small projects get funded too and large projects don't use up all funding?

Significant weight will be given to projects in areas of high energy costs and the requirement that there be a state-wide balance of projects approved for funding. In addition, the amount of match (in-kind or cash) provided by the applicants also will be considered in determining who is approved for funding.

3. Can we have the regional wind study results?  
AEA will release a draft version soon.

4. Can we have wind maps for our area?  
AEA will publish community wind maps on our web-page soon.

5. Can we send in the same proposal for two rounds?

All proposals satisfying all three stages of the review process and are deemed good projects will be forwarded to the Legislature for consideration.

6. Question regarding the eligibility of waste vegetable oil?

If the applicant is an eligible entity, the public is served, and the fuel source is determined to be a renewable resource; then applications will be accepted and evaluated. See also FAQ #2 (Applicant Eligibility, question #1).
