The training session is two weeks long and will be held online through AVTEC in Seward, Alaska. Students who complete and pass the course will receive a certificate.

If you are interested in this upcoming class, you will need to complete and submit an application, by November 19, 2021. As the class is on a first-come, first-served basis, we encourage you to submit your application as soon as possible.

# Alaska Energy Authority Training Program Statement of Understanding

#### ZERO-TOLERANCE & INCOMPLETION POLICY

The Alaska Energy Authority (AEA) has implemented a zero-tolerance policy for the use or possession of alcohol and illegal drugs within its training programs.
